

**Inorganic Division  
Treasurer's Report  
2014**

1. This report for the ID reflects the period from May 15, 2013 to May 25, 2014.
2. The finances for the Inorganic Division of the CSC are in excellent shape. As of May, 2014 the net worth of the Division is approximately \$48,339.93. This amount includes the value of the Trust Fund (\$40,000, invested Feb 2, 2012, 2.35%, 5-year term; interest over two years to Feb 2014, \$1902, was reinvested) and available cash (\$6437.93) in the operating account. The divisional grant from the CIC for 2014 is \$1809.22 (cf. \$1654.96 in 2013, \$1656.90 in 2012).
3. The Inorganic Division has provided \$750 in awards to students at graduate and undergraduate research conferences since May 15, 2013 (each \$150).

4. The Inorganic Division paid out \$650 for the DIC Graduate Student Prize in 2014 (Mita Dasog) and a contribution of \$125 to the E.W.R. Steacie Award (2013, Lewis Kay). The Pure or Applied Inorganic Chemistry Award is funded entirely by Strem Chemicals Inc. (\$1,500) through to the end of 2016 and a donor is also sponsoring the Award for Undergraduate Research in Chemistry (AURIC, \$150) 2014 (E. Bowes).
5. The Inorganic Division gave \$300 toward undergraduate and graduate poster awards at the CSC-2013 (coordinated by the Chem Ed Division) and a donor contributed a further \$200 by sponsoring the undergraduate awards.
