- Number of student **applicants** for ICE 2018: 28 (24 in 2017; 29 in 2016)
- Number of supervisors for ICE 2018: 9 for 7 exchanges (7 for 6 exchanges in 2017; 6 in 2016; 7 in 2015; 12 in 2014)
- NSERC USRA success rate for ICE in 2018: 2/7 + 2 other awards (3/6 + 1 other award in 2017; 4/6 +1 CREATE in 2016)
- Total number of **ICE Scholars** since 2004: 117
- Total number of faculty supervisors since 2004: 49
- Total number of participating Universities since 2004: >20
